# Message from Mike...

Hello church family,

As you are reading this the Easter period has mostly passed. We have reflectively remembered Jesus' death and celebrated his resurrection, yet there is so much more in the resurrection story that connects us to the Apostles.

The two on the way to Emmaus didn't recognise Jesus until he broke bread. How often do we fail to see Jesus working in our lives and our church because we are so busy with or grieving over an event. We fail to realise that Jesus is there right through it all bringing the absolutely best possible outcome.

Perhaps we identify with the disciples who went fishing waiting for Jesus to come and see them. Peter was the instigator of this, realising he had failed Jesus spectacularly, he had little expectation of being Peter, the rock, ever again. Yet Jesus met them on the beach, and once again they experience His wonderful provision of a catch of fish so huge. This repeated Peters experience at the start of being a disciple and began the restoration process. And then at breakfast on the beach fully restored Peter and confirmed his ministry. Whenever we feel we have failed there is always restoration.

Thomas we can also relate to, who doubted Jesus was alive. We also sometimes struggle with doubt and we haven't seen Jesus in the flesh. Jesus said "happy are those who believe and have not seen" John 20 verse 29. That is us and everyone since Jesus ascended into heaven. We are especially blessed because we have believed in Jesus without meeting Him in the flesh. We meet Him through the Holy Spirit who guides us to the Truth, Jesus.

Be encouraged. If we doubt, if we fail, even if we don't always recognise Jesus, He always loves us, wants to restore us and loves the reveal Himself to us. Be looking for our Lord in the most unusual places. Believe me when I say, if you search for Him with all your heart you will find Him

You will seek Him and you will find Him, when you search for Him with all you heart – Jeremiah 29 verse 13.
